## Handwriting

Handwriting does not have to be practiced with a pencil, pen and paper. There are alternatives you can use such as flour, sand, mud, sticks, oats, brush and water.

Can you practice the letter **c**?

Write the letter, words and a sentence. Make sure you are making your tall letters tall, your long letters long and you are trying to keep your letters the right size. If your child struggles to form letters, practice writing in the air and carpet and show them how to write it first.

clapped

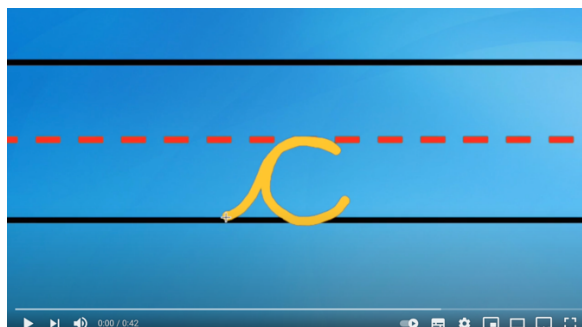
cat

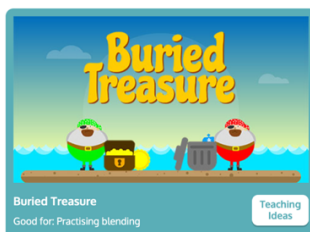

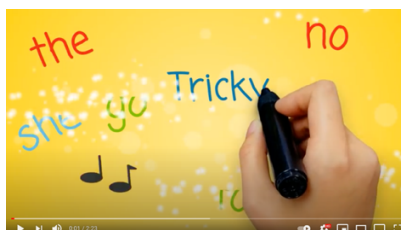
Play the 'Flash Cards Speed Trial' game selecting phases 2 and 3 (not all will know all phase 3 phonemes but have a go!):

a bit foggy

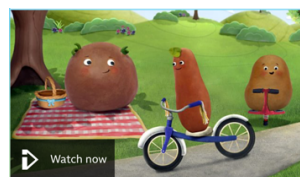
