Try writing:




Parent answer:

Circle the addition and subtraction number sentences that match the ten frames.





| $15 + 3 = 18$ | $15 - 3 = 18$ |
| $3 + 18 = 15$ | $18 - 15 = 3$ |
| $18 + 3 = 15$ | $18 - 3 = 15$ |
| $18 = 3 + 15$ | $15 - 18 = 3$ |

Parent answer:


