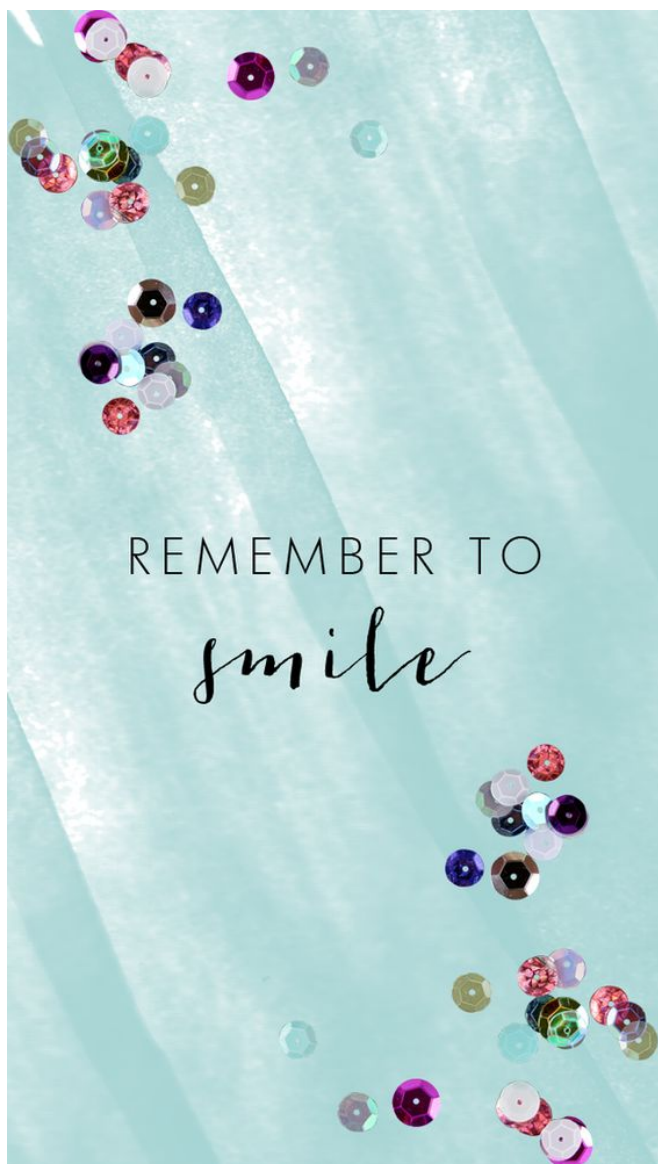
Hello everyone,

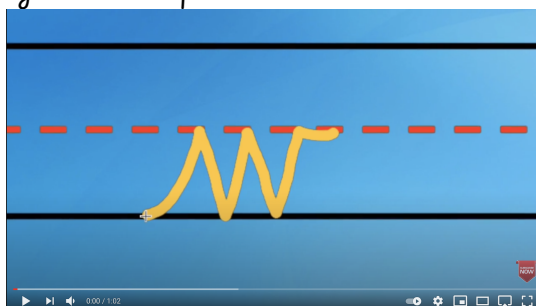

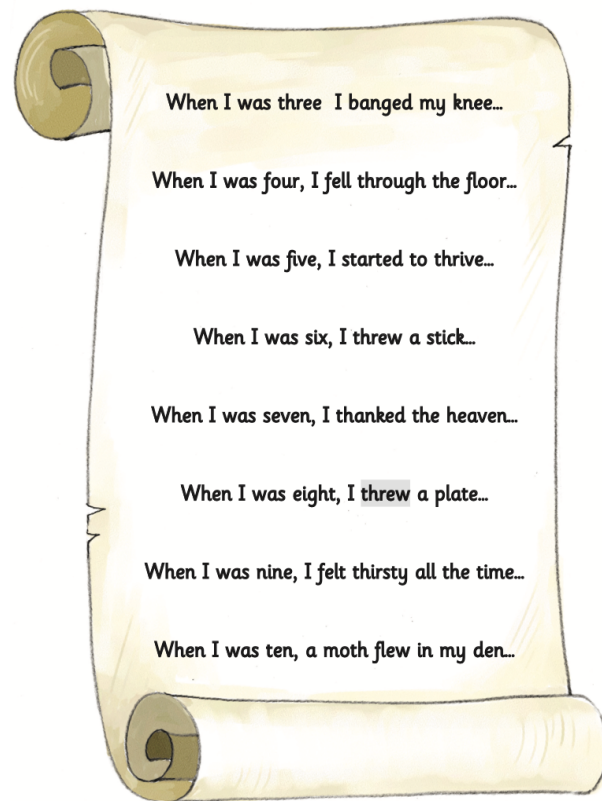

Read the scroll, add sound buttons and zips to th words, do the action each time

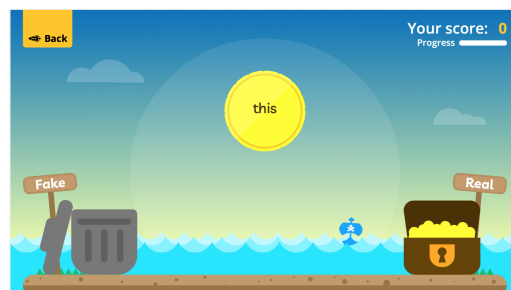
