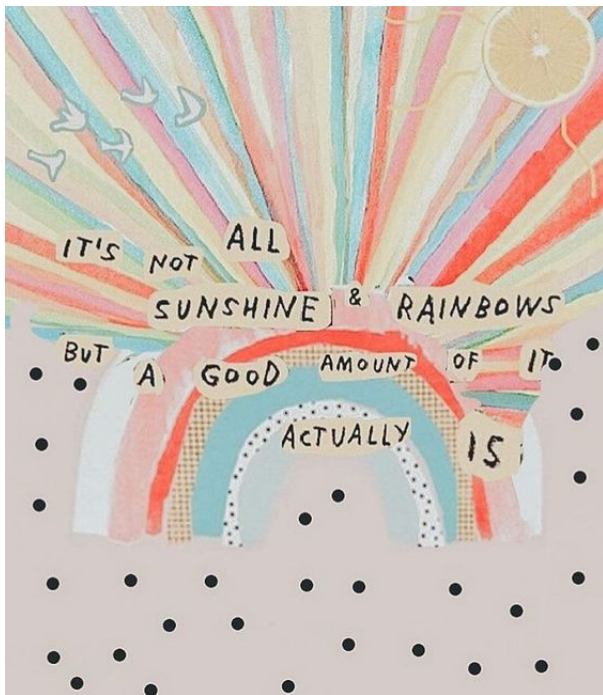
Hello all,

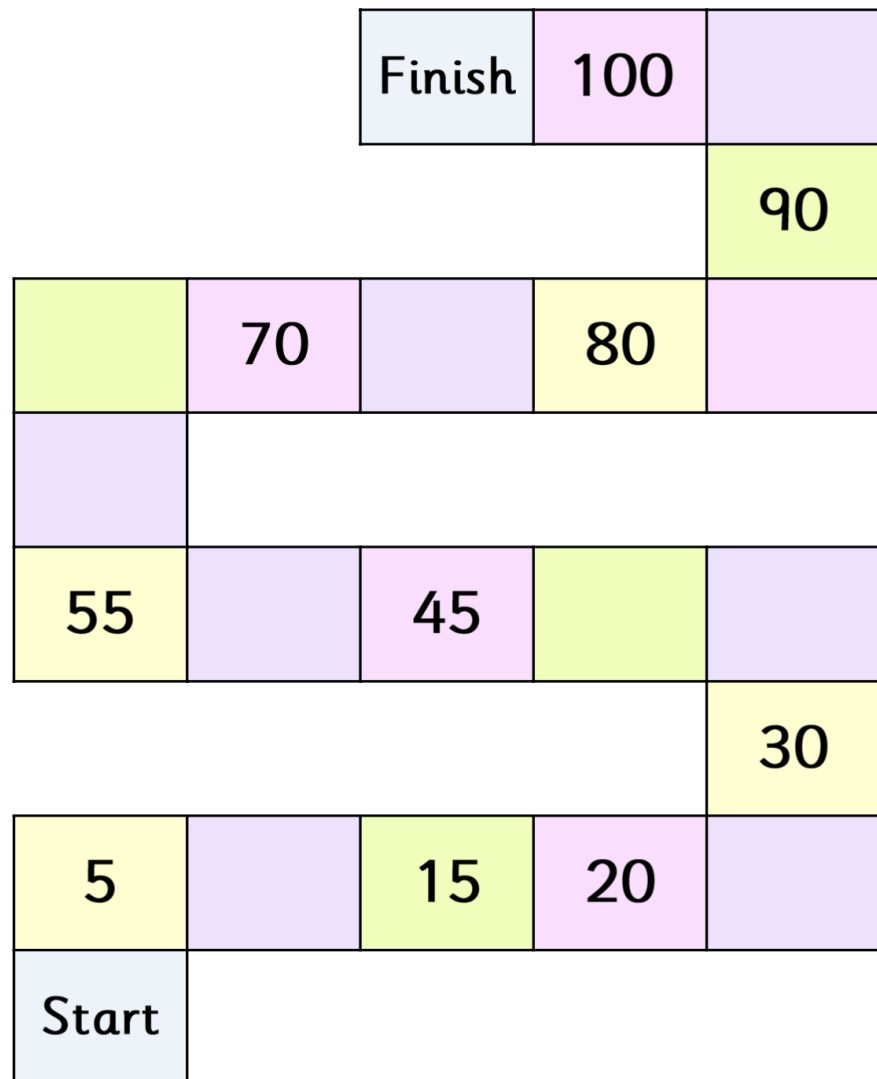
Game – Counting in 2s

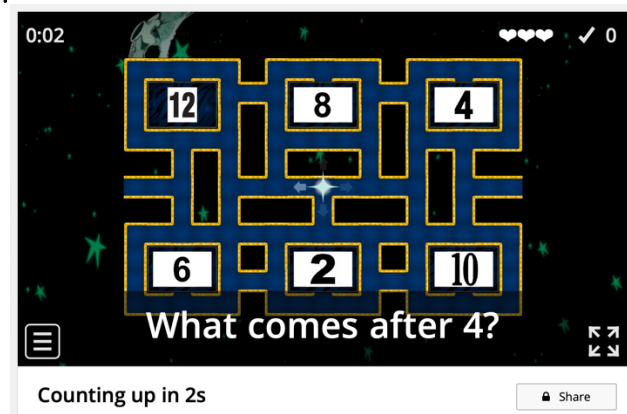
Game – Counting in 5s

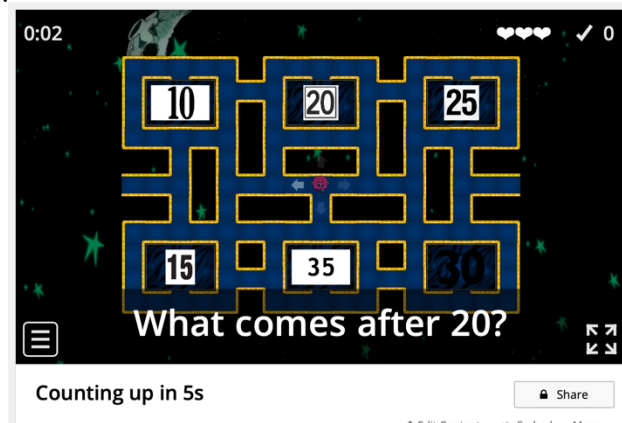

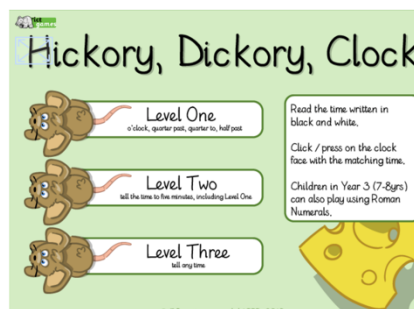
